Timetable for Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday visits

- 10am Arrival. Welcome. Group base for the day, lunch area, etc. Health and Safety brief (fire assembly, exits etc). Toilet stop.
- 10.20-10.50 external Lancaster tour describing features of the aircraft, the crew and some Victoria Cross stories.

- Mission Berlin. As a class we take up the roles of Bomber aircraft and the defenders of the Reich and try to understand what both sides needed to consider during the bomber offensive. This is a hands-on game!
- 11.20-12.15 first session. Group will be split into 2 if the group size is over 30. One will commence a self-led session trail around the museum site with quiz trail. The other group will work with the session instructor.
- 12.15-1pm LUNCH
- 1pm-2pm second session (swap over)
- 2-2.15 Plenary and DEPART

Timetable for Tuesdays ONLY (Lancaster Taxi run days. Get to see this icon of the sky start up and taxi out! Hear the sound of the legendary Merlin engines!)

- 10am Arrival. Welcome. Group base for the day, lunch area, etc. Health and Safety brief (fire assembly, exits etc). Toilet stop.
